REVIEW AND APPROVE OF MINUTES FROM JANUARY 8, 2020 MEETING

STUDENT ONLINE PERSONAL PROTECTION ACT (SOPPA)

Dr. Wroblewski and Mrs. Williams updated the committee on the Student Online Personal Protection Act (SOPPA) which goes into effect July 2021. Mrs. Williams discussed the SOPPA Act and what the requirements are currently. SOPPA places regulations on transparency and student data use, meaning that ISBE, Operators and School Districts must be more forthcoming with what student data is being collected and how it is being used. And requires all parties to adhere to best security practices and breach notifications.

NEW COURSE PROPOSAL SPORTS MEDICINE I & II

Dr. Wroblewski updated the committee on the Sports Medicine I- is an opportunity for the student to learn the application of the components of sports medicine. This course will introduce the student to the basic principles and techniques of the prevention, recognition, treatment and rehabilitation of common injuries and illnesses. Included in the class will be the development of skills required to provide supporting taping, wrapping, and splinting for athletes involved in competition. The class will be available to grades 11 and 12. Amount of credit will be 0.5 and will be an Honors level class. Fee of \$25.00 per semester and possible prerequisites of Anatomy class but not required. On Sports Medicine II- this course will further explain the student to the basic principals and techniques of the prevention, recognition, treatment and rehabilitation of common injuries and illnesses. The focus on learning the individual joints, mechanisms of injury, levels of severity for injuries, anatomical landmarks, musculature, nerve innervation, taping and wrapping specific to each joint and rehabilitation techniques. The class will be available to grades 11 and 12. Amount of credit will be 0.5 and will be an Honors level class. Fee of \$25.00 per semester and possible prerequisites of Anatomy class but not required.


