



Hybrid In-Person & Remote Learning Schedule 2.0

Modified Remote Schedule

Below is the schedule for the first week of the second quarter.

Monday, October 19: Red Day

Tuesday, October 20: Green Day

Wednesday, October 21: Cavs Day

Thursday, October 22: Remote Learning Planning Day (No Student Attendance)

Friday, October 23: Parent-Teacher Conferences (No Student Attendance)

Beginning October 26, 2020, ALL students will transition to full synchronous remote learning (Every Day is a Cavs Day) and will attend on-line classes five-days per week from 7:45 am to 12:06 pm.

Return to Hybrid In-Person Learning Criteria

It is the goal of the District to return to hybrid in-person learning. Central to doing so is maintaining the health and safety of all students and staff. The *CDC Metrics on Indicators and Thresholds for Risk of Introduction and Transmission of COVID in Schools* is a primary tool guiding our decision on when to bring students back into the building for classes. This tool tracks three core indicators: 1) Number of new cases per 100,000 persons within the last 14-days; 2) Percentage of COVID-19 tests that are positive during the last 14-days; and 3) Ability of the school to implement five key mitigation strategies.

When we have an overall rating of moderate level of risk or better in the core indicators, the District will resume hybrid in-person learning. While all three indicators are important, students will return to hybrid in-person learning when the composite percentage (14-day rolling average) of positive cases remains under 8% for 14 consecutive days. The 14-day tracking period begins Thursday, October 15, 2020.

Hybrid In-Person Schedule

Hybrid In-Person students attend LP classes in person on the following days:

- **Red Day (M & W)** – In-person learning for students with the last names A through Limberg.
- **Green Day (T & Th)** – In-person learning for students with the last names Link through Z.

On their remote days, hybrid in-person students will attend all classes remotely. All hybrid in-person students attend Friday classes remotely.

Remote Learning students attend LP classes Monday through Friday online from 7:45 am to 12:06 pm.

Goals, Life-Skills, Transitions, Oasis, & Pride programs will attend in-person Monday through Thursday and remote on Friday.

Curriculum

Teachers will continue utilizing Edgenuity as a resource for supplementing their lessons. With the transition to synchronous learning, there will be some time needed for students to catch up on their missing Edgenuity lessons and for teachers to readjust their curriculum sequence based on teaching all students five-days per week. Pacing of the curriculum and student workload will still be considered under the unique circumstances of the pandemic.

Guiding Principles for Planning:

1. Maintain the health and safety of all students and staff;
2. Provide meaningful and engaging learning experiences for all students;
3. Address the social-emotional needs of all students;
4. Provide clarity, consistency, and stability for all students and staff; and
5. Provide ongoing professional development for staff to address the learning needs unique to the time.

Health & Safety Protocols

Signs & Symptoms

Parents are responsible for keeping your child(ren) home if they are showing any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, which includes but not limited to fever over 100.4°, cough, shortness of breath, chills, fatigue, muscle & body aches, headache, sore throat, nausea, diarrhea, or vomiting. Signs of COVID-19 during the school day will be sent to the quarantine station. Prior to returning to hybrid in-person learning, students with pre-existing conditions are requested to provide a doctor's note.

Temperature & Symptoms Checks

All students will have their temperature taken upon arrival. Students who show symptoms or have a temperature over 100.4° will be sent home after a parent is contacted.

Social Distancing

Students and staff will maintain social distance of 6 feet from one another whenever possible.

Masks

Masks covering the nose and mouth will always be required of staff and students.

School Sanitation

Classrooms will be provided with hand sanitizer and equipment to clean furniture and door handles each period. Custodial staff will disinfect bathrooms every hour and at the end of each day. Friday's will be a super-clean day. Cleaning will include applying disinfectant using an electro-static spray.
